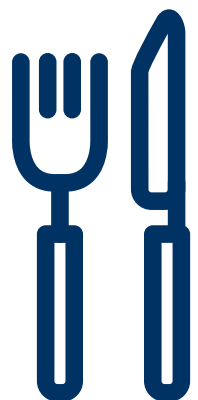


## SUCCESSFUL FUNDRAISING IDEAS



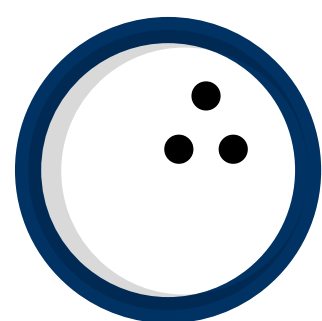
