

HOW TO BE A SUCCESSFUL ST. CATHERINE CHALLENGE STUDENT COORDINATOR

Set a fundraising goal – aim HIGH!

Determine what the goal of your school is to raise funds for the St. Catherine Challenge. Aim higher than the amount you raised in previous years! One way to start is to divide your fundraising goal among all of your participants (your recruitment goal). For example, if your goal is \$1000 and you have 20 participants, each participant should raise \$50 to reach your goal.

Set a recruitment goal

Are you in Pi Theta Epsilon, SOTA, or another student organization? Set a target for the number of students from this organization you want to recruit to participate in fundraising efforts for the AOTF St. Catherine Challenge. The more students that are active, the more money you can raise!

Spread the word! Announce the St. Catherine Challenge at your next meeting

Share your commitment to fundraise for the St. Catherine Challenge with your entire organization. Announce opportunities for them to get involved, or how they can make a personal donation.
