- A description of 250 words or less detailing the proposed use of honorarium to further the understanding of sensory integration and brain-behavior relationships as related to occupational therapy. The candidate must submit this description (examples of possible uses are: development of a workshop, writing a grant, collecting and analyzing data, attending a workshop or conference, buying books or partial tuition support for furthering education in the field of brain-behavior relationships).
- Current curriculum vitae of candidate, which must include a list of contributions such as outstanding clinical expertise, presentations, seminars, symposia, workshops, scientific papers, awards, and honors, and/or publications.
- Reprints of publications published in external professional journals, if applicable.
- Recent photograph of candidate suitable for reproduction (hi-resolution 300 dpi or greater, .jpeg preferred).
- A short paragraph of no more than 100 words citing the candidate's contributions to be used for public dissemination.
