PTE PRESIDENT'S AWARD

The President's Award has been established to honor and recognize Pi Theta Epsilon chapters who organize and implement outstanding scholarly activities. Examples of these events/activities are those developed to increase knowledge, demonstrate chapter leadership, develop professional skills, and further contribute to the advancement of occupational therapy. The event must be complete between January 1st and October 31st annually. Each chapter may submit one application which details one scholarly chapter event. All applications must be postmarked and mailed to the PTE national office by November 1st. Applications will be reviewed by the national PTE executive committee and the winner will be determined by a majority vote of that committee. The winning chapter will be notified by December 15th. All submitted applications will be published in the Spring issue of the Scroll and Pen. The winning chapter will also be recognized at the American Occupational Therapy Association Annual Conference and Exposition's Award Ceremony and during the PTE Annual Business Meeting held yearly.
